MADE IN TASHKEEL 2020

The annual summer group exhibition at Tashkeel presents selected recent works by Tashkeel members (past and present), residents and workshop/exhibition participants over the last 12 months. It aims to explore the current depth and diversity of contemporary practice by UAE-based artists and designers.

Submission deadline: 10pm, Tuesday 5 May

Selection made: Thursday 14 May

Delivery period: Saturday 16 May – Monday 1 June (excluding Fridays and public holidays)

Exhibition opening: 7pm, Tuesday 9 June

Submission Guidelines:

- Eligible artists/designers are those who: 1) have been/are members; or 2) have previously exhibited with Tashkeel; 3) have participated in Tashkeel workshops over the last 12 months 4) or has produced work in whole or part using Tashkeel facilities over the last 12 months (since 1 May 2019).
 - The call is open to contemporary art and design work in any medium.
 - Submissions must be of work completed since 1 May 2019. Older works will not be accepted.
 - Submissions must be original and entirely the work of the applicant.
 - The completed application form and images should be sent by email to submission@tashkeel.org under the subject of 'Made in Tashkeel 2020 Submission: [YOUR NAME]' by 10pm, Tuesday 5 May 2020.
 - Images of submitted works should be high resolution, JPEG or TIFF; video works at least 720 x 576 PAL or 720 x 480 NTSC; audio works (wav or aiff) should be submitted via wetransfer or hand delivered to Tashkeel, Nad Al Sheba 1.
 - For 3D work, installation instructions illustrated with two or more images are required.
 - Selected applicants will be notified by email by Thursday 14 May 2020.
 - Selected applicants will be responsible for the framing and mounting of their works to a professional standard before delivering them to Tashkeel.
 - Selected applicants will be required to deliver works to Tashkeel between Saturday 16 May – Monday 1 June (excluding Fridays and public holidays). During The Holy Month of Ramadan, operating hours will change to 9am–5pm.
 - Tashkeel reserves the right to decline to exhibit works once delivered to Tashkeel.
